6. The Sword of the Spirit - Vs. 17

- You are a soldier, you are in a battle, and this is your weapon, we need to know our weapon!
- Follow a reading plan for the whole Bible, otherwise we tend to miss out on some of the more obscure books that God wants to speak to us from!

<u>Title</u>: "Ready for the Fray?"

Text: Ephesians 6:10-20

Intro:

- When Paul wrote the book of Ephesians these early Christians were under attack
 - 1. Through persecution
 - 2. Doctrinally
- The Armour is given to us at conversion but we must put it on.
- Our battle is NOT against man. Our battle IS against evil authorities of the unseen world and spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.
- If this is our enemy what does it look like to put on the full armour of God?

1. The belt of truth - Vs. 14

- Are you a lover of truth?
- Our enemy is the father of lies.
- Through His Word, God is constantly warning us not to be deceived (1 Cor. 6:9-10, 15:33, Gal. 6:7-8, 1 John 1:8)

2. The breastplate of righteousness - Vs. 14

- Putting on the breastplate of righteousness begins by taking off our righteousness.
- We don't have to rely on our righteousness anymore because he has given us His. (1Cor. 1:30)
- 3. The shoes of the Gospel of peace Vs. 15 (John 14:27)
 - Anxiety and fear can keep us from standing firm against the enemy.
 - As we take our eyes off our obstacle and place them on the Lord, our fear can then begin to go and the peace of Christ can begin to fill that now empty spot.

4. The shield of faith - Vs. 16

- We need to aide the process of building up our shield (faith). Jude 1:20
- We get faith by hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17)
- Therefore we need to put ourselves in places where God's Word is shared - friends, cell group, church etc.

5. The Helmet of salvation - Vs. 17

_

- The helmet of salvation is so much more then heaven and hell. As a result of your salvation you are a new creation!
 - One of the ways we put on the helmet of salvation is to know who we are in Christ!
 - Start by memorizing 5 or 10 verses of who are as a result of your salvation.
 Here are a few to get you started. - John 1:12, John 15:15, Rom. 8:14-15, 17, 1Cor. 3:16, 2Cor. 5:17, Eph. 1:1, Eph 2:10, Eph. 4:24, 1Thess. 1:4.
