A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

Author, Tom Harpur, said that most of our prayers have as much passion to them as a kiss on the cheek from a great aunt or from an aged grandparent on one's 21st birthday...they lack "suction". Small wonder then that our prayers thus tend to become boring, flat and unable to move our own soul! It is important that we move from the anemic and the formal to something solid and down to earth....something with a true suction on our lives! So how can we change the nature of our prayers? First of all, hold nothing back. Pour your whole self into your prayer. Pour out your heart to the Lord. Pray aloud. Use the most simple direct language you know. When you can't think of what to say or how to say it, keep silent before the Lord. It is helpful to use the Psalms and read them aloud in order to increase the *suction*. Gently gaze at the Lord and bless His Name. Whisper, shout, kneel or lay before Him. Do whatever you need to increase God's passion in your heart. Telling the Lord how many things you are truly grateful for is a perfect way to end your prayer moment.
