- 2. Christians are responsible for care. God is responsible for cure!**
 - Our main job in this world is to create *therapeutic situations* that build up people in need (2 Corinthians 1:4; Psalm 23:3)
- 3. We don't need to control everyone or push hard for growth or change**
- 4. Helping people through difficult and critical periods in their lives or resolving problems is hard work**
